# Proposal Services

- One-on-one consultations and personalized strategic planning
- Funding search assistance
- Identification of potential collaborators, mentors, and reviewers
- Project management: checklists, outlines, timelines, collaboration space (e.g., Teams)
- Editorial support: content editing (2 weeks) and copyediting (1 week)
- Expert review (6-7 weeks):
  - Internal mock review panel with 2-3 FSU faculty experts
  - **NEW:** External proposal review program with outside expert(s)

# Large Team Proposal Services

- The RD team can also help with large team efforts
- Team management throughout proposal preparation
  - Online collaboration and project management systems
  - Collection of information and supporting documents (e.g., role statements, biosketches, letters of support) from team members
  - Task delegation and accountability
  - Timelines to keep the team on track for the deadline

# Team Development & Research Proposal Support for Efforts \$10M+

- Large, multi-disciplinary, center-level efforts
  - Team science expertise
  - Team development programming
    - Establishing shared expectations
    - Creating collaboration agreements
    - Guiding brainstorming activities
  - Project management and support

# Limited Submissions

- Limited Submission = Sponsor restricts the # of applications from a single organization
- FSU screens pre-proposals or nominations to determine which applications move forward for competition
- The RD team tracks available programs, solicits notices of interest from faculty, and manages internal competitions for these opportunities

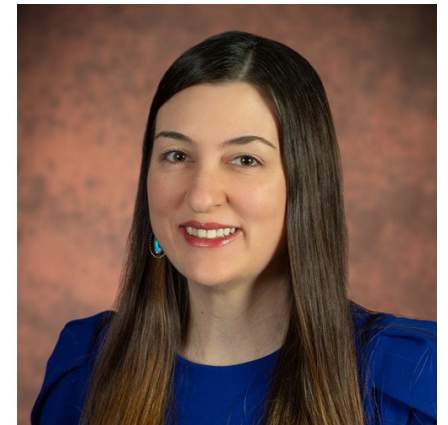

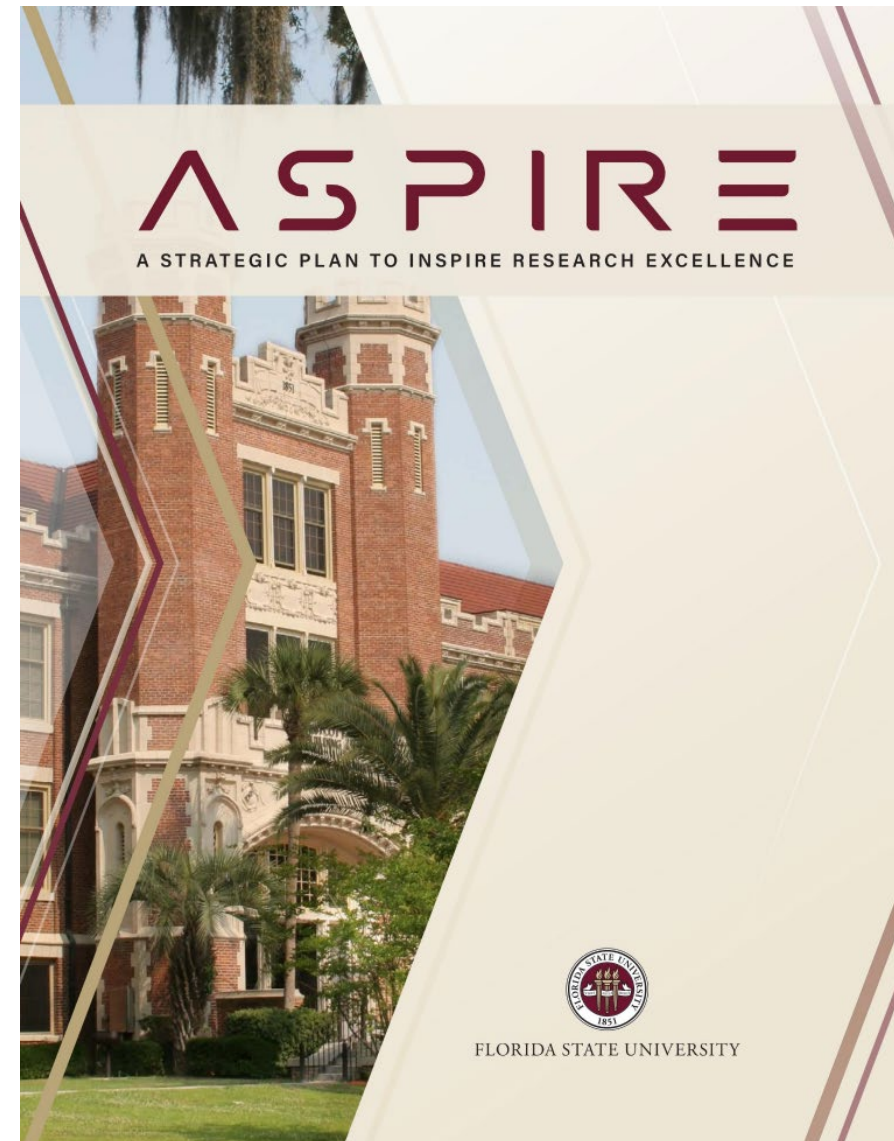
